
Beginner

We begin every class by practicing daily conversation dialogues. We ask openended questions to exercise students' thinking process, develop their speech and language skills, and build confidence.

Online

3 Students Per Class 35-45 minutes



Next, students are led through English worksheets to help them articulate in full sentences with the correct grammar and sentence structure.



Knowing your audience is key, so students read a story to familiarize themselves with their poem or speech of the day. Students learning in-person complete a hands-on project as well!



Students then practice speaking with the appropriate volume, speed, body language and audience engagement.
